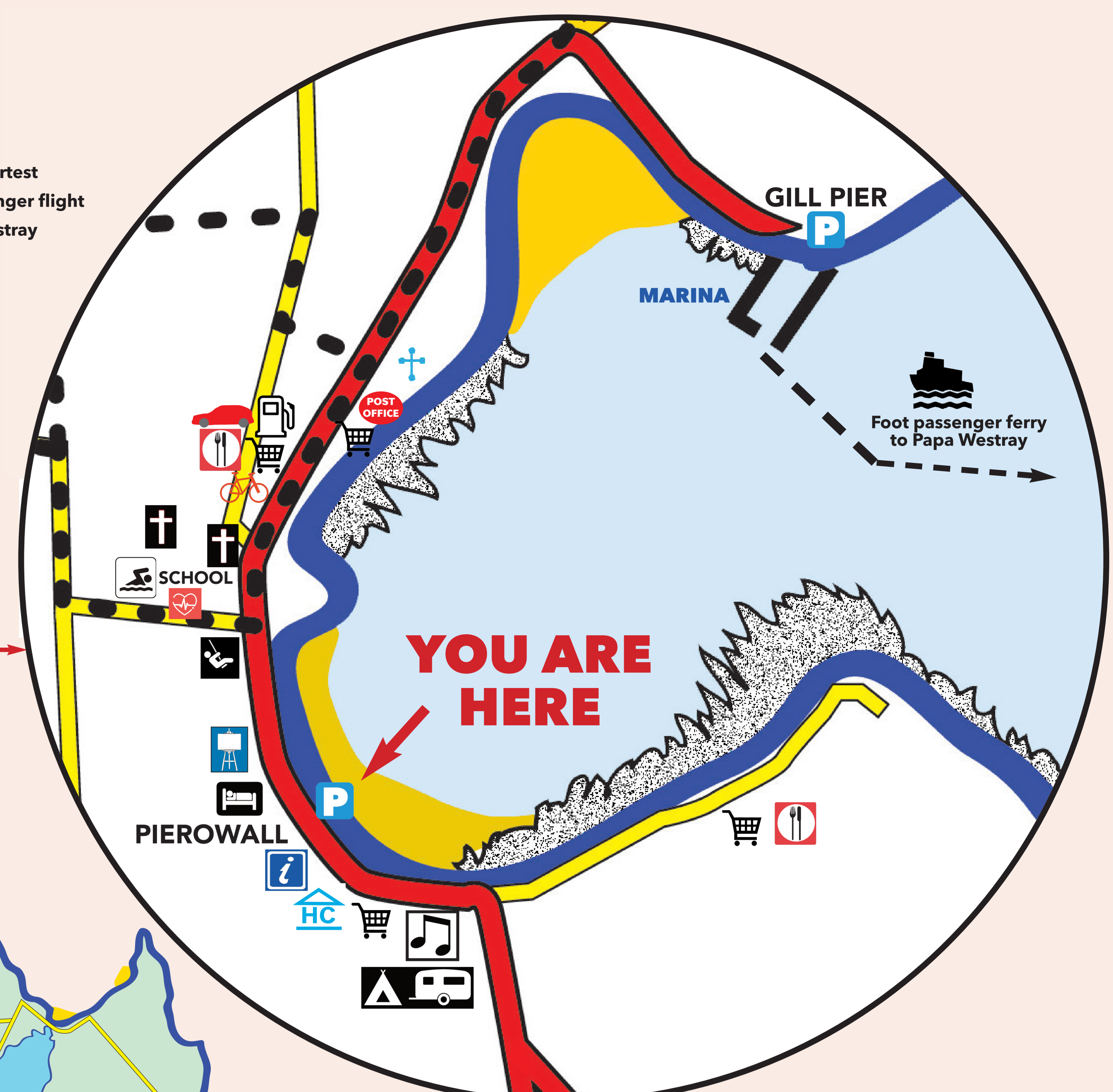




World's shortest scheduled passenger flight to Papa Westray

- WALKS**
Degree of difficulty for walking (1 - easy, 3 - hard)
- ① West Westray walk from Kirbest to Backarass 8.8km (5.5m)
 - ② Noup Head loop from Backarass to Backarass 8.8km (5.5m)
 - ③ Kirk to Castle walk 6km (3.7m)
 - ④ Tuquoy and Mae Sand 3.6km (2.2m)
 - ⑤ Castle o' Burrian and Bay of Tafts 1.24km (0.75m) to see the puffins (May-late July), can be extended to a circular walk 5.5km (3.5m)
 - ⑥ FITTY HILL 1.4km (1m)
